

How to install Adobe Flash Player on a Mac using Application Portal

Information

1. Download the latest Standalone Installer of Adobe Flash Player.

Example of the command used to create the file in the .cmmac format:

```
./CMAppUtil -c install_flash_player_16_osx.dmg -o ~/Desktop/
```

When you have the .cmmac file, copy it to a network share where it can be accessed from the computer running the Configuration Manager console. In our example the file name is *Install Adobe Flash Player.app.cmmac*

- 3. Create a Configuration Manager application using the Create Application Wizard. See <u>Parallels Mac Management for SCCM 2012 Administrators Guide.pdf</u>, pages 90-92 for detailed instructions.
- 4. Specify the Installation Command Line.
 - './Install Adobe Flash Player.app/Contents/MacOS/Adobe Flash Player Install Manager' -install
- 5. Deploy Adobe Flash Player on the selected Macs
- 6. Install Application on a Mac.
