Symptoms

• When I am trying to activate Parallels Desktop, I get the following error message:

Cause

The license key was used to activate more than one copy of Parallels Desktop for Mac.

Resolution

The End User License Agreement states the following:

The Software is available?under?both?Perpetual and?Subscription Licenses.?Each?license?allows You to install and use one copy of the Software on a single computing device.?You?may?have?up to five licenses?for the Software?which would allow?You?to?install a single copy of the Software on?up to five computing devices. If You are an Entity that is acquiring, or allowing the acquiring of, such licenses for use of the Software on or through Your Assets, then the foregoing limitation of number of licenses would apply throughout Your organization. If You need to use more than five Licenses, then You must purchase?a?license?for the business edition of the Software?under the terms of the <u>BULA</u> (Business User License Agreement).?
