

Adding a key manager in a Parallels business account

An administrator of a business account can give other regular members of the business account permission to view and manage a business product license or sublicense.

To give the permission, follow these steps:

1. Add a regular non-admin member to the business account, on the user invitation page.

NOTE: If the member is already added with the **Account Administrator** role, it should be demoted to **Regular Member**:
