



## **Do not Disturb mode is activated on the Mac after launching an application inside a Windows virtual machine**

### **Symptoms**

After launching an application inside a Windows virtual machine, Do Not Disturb mode is activated on the Mac side.

Grayed out Notification Center icon indicates that Do Not Disturb mode has been activated.

### **Resolution**

To disable Do Not Disturb mode on the Mac do the following:

1. Right-click/Control-click on the application icon in the Dock.
2. Move the mouse cursor to App Settings menu item and using its submenu uncheck Do Not Disturb.

3. As a result, the Notification Center icon should be back to normal and Do Not Disturb mode will be deactivated.
