

Where are settings of Parallels Client for Linux stored?

Information

This article outlines how to examine or edit settings of Parallels Client for Linux not using its GUI.

Resolution

User Client settings are stored in `~/.config/2X/Client/default.2xc`. It can be opened by any text editor, e.g. **nano**. Just type the following command in Terminal:

```
nano ~/.config/2X/Client/default.2xc
```

The file will be opened for editing.

Press **Ctrl+J** to justify the text and **Ctrl+W** – to find the parameter which you are interested in.

For example, if you would like to enable Extended logging, go to **LogLevel** key and change its value from **3** to **5**:

Then press **Ctrl+X** and **Y** to apply the changes.

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
