On Mac computers with Intel processors, Parallels Desktop uses its system extensions to provide you with the best performance, functionality, and seamless experience. Parallels works closely with Apple® to ensure that Parallels Desktop continues to function in future releases of macOS.

Starting with macOS Big Sur, you can switch from Parallels to Apple system extensions:

1. Shut down the virtual machine via **Actions** > **Shut Down**.

- 2. Open the virtual machine's configuration (click Parallels Desktop icon on the Mac menu bar > Control Center > right click on the virtual machine > Configure).
- 3. Go to Hardware > CPU & Memory > Advanced Settings > and change Hypervisor to Apple.

Note: Parallels hypervisor enables some advanced features, such as <u>nested virtualization</u>. Therefore, switching to Apple hypervisor may not be advisable in cases when these features are essential.
