

How to completely remove Parallels Device Management

• Parallels Device Management

Procedure for removing PDM with leftovers on servers

- 1. Run the uninstaller.
- 2. Delete registry key:

HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Wow6432Node\Parallels\Parallels Mac Management for Microsoft SCCM

- 3. Delete PDM database:
- Open Microsoft SQL Server management Studio and find PMM_XXX database
- Select it, open context menu and click **Delete**:

4. Delete WMI Objects:

NOTE: You should be logged into the system with a WMI-privileged account. Local admin permission level should be enough.

- Open wbemtest.exe
- Connect to <i>root\sms\site_XXX</i> (where <i>XXX</i> is a Site Code)





(Get-WmiObject -Namespace "root\sms\site_CPA" -Query "SELECT * FROM SMS_SCI_Configuration WHERE ItemName LIKE 'Parallels%' OR ItemName LIKE 'Pmm%'" | Remove-WmiObject **5. Delete AD objects.**
