



How to make right-click on Mac and in Parallels Desktop virtual machine

- Parallels Desktop for Mac Standard Edition

By default, Parallels Desktop is set to mimic a right-click when you press **Shift+Control** (see below) and click the mouse.

There are alternative ways to do that:

1. Using Apple mighty/magic mouse:

- ◆ Click on the **Apple sign** in top left corner of your screen and choose **System Preferences**.
- ◆ Click on **Mouse** and choose **Click on right side** in **Secondary Click**.
- ◆ Now you will easily use right-click by clicking on the right side of your mouse.

2. If you prefer using **TrackPad** for right-click, you can follow the steps from below:

- ◆ Click on the **Apple sign** in top left corner of your screen and choose **System Preferences**.
- ◆ Click on **TrackPad** and put a checkmark on **Click or tap with two fingers for Secondary click**.
- ◆ Now you can use two fingers touch for right-click.

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
