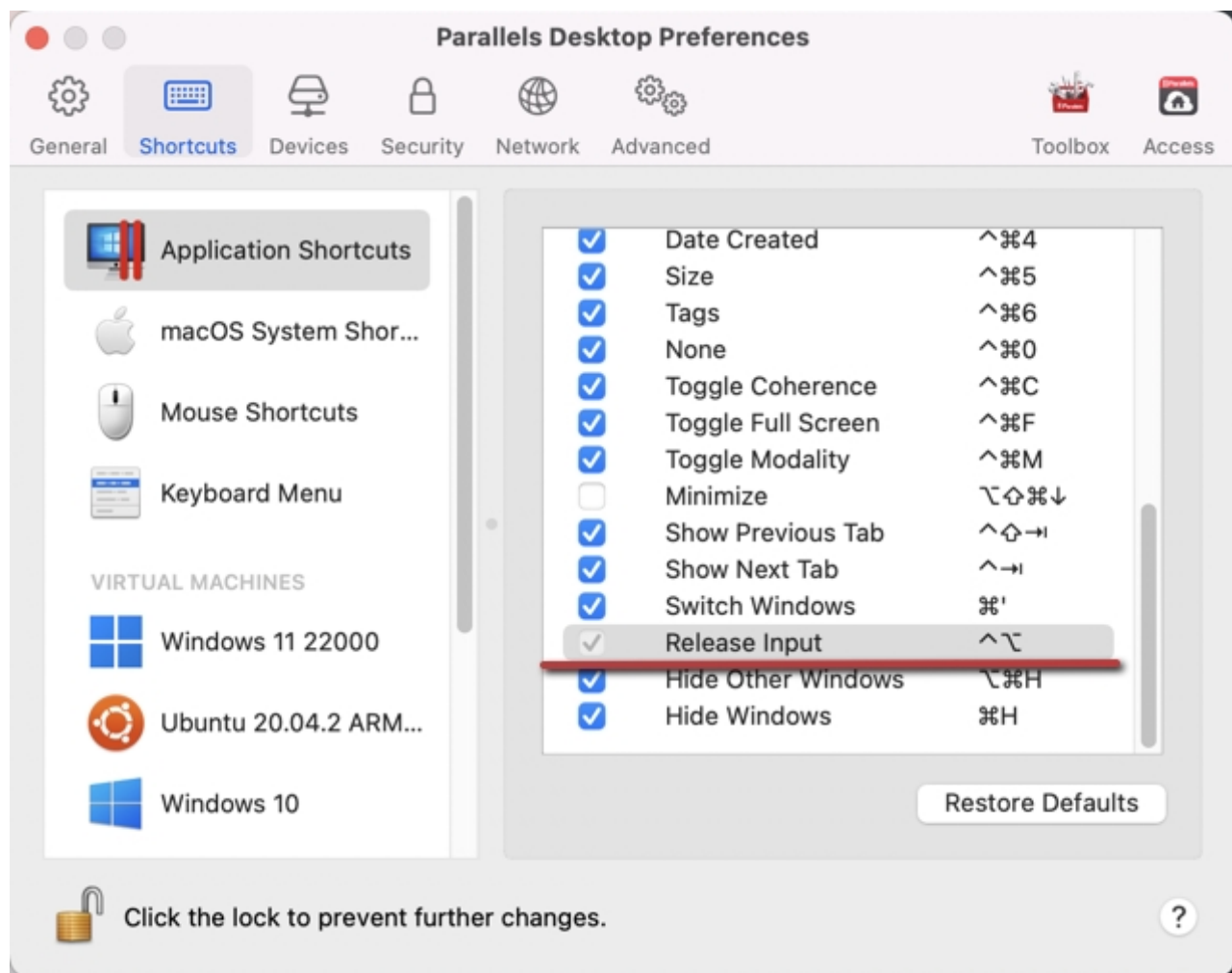


Remap "Release Input" (Ctrl+Option) Parallels Desktop Shortcut

- Parallels Desktop for Mac Pro Edition
- Parallels Desktop for Mac Business Edition

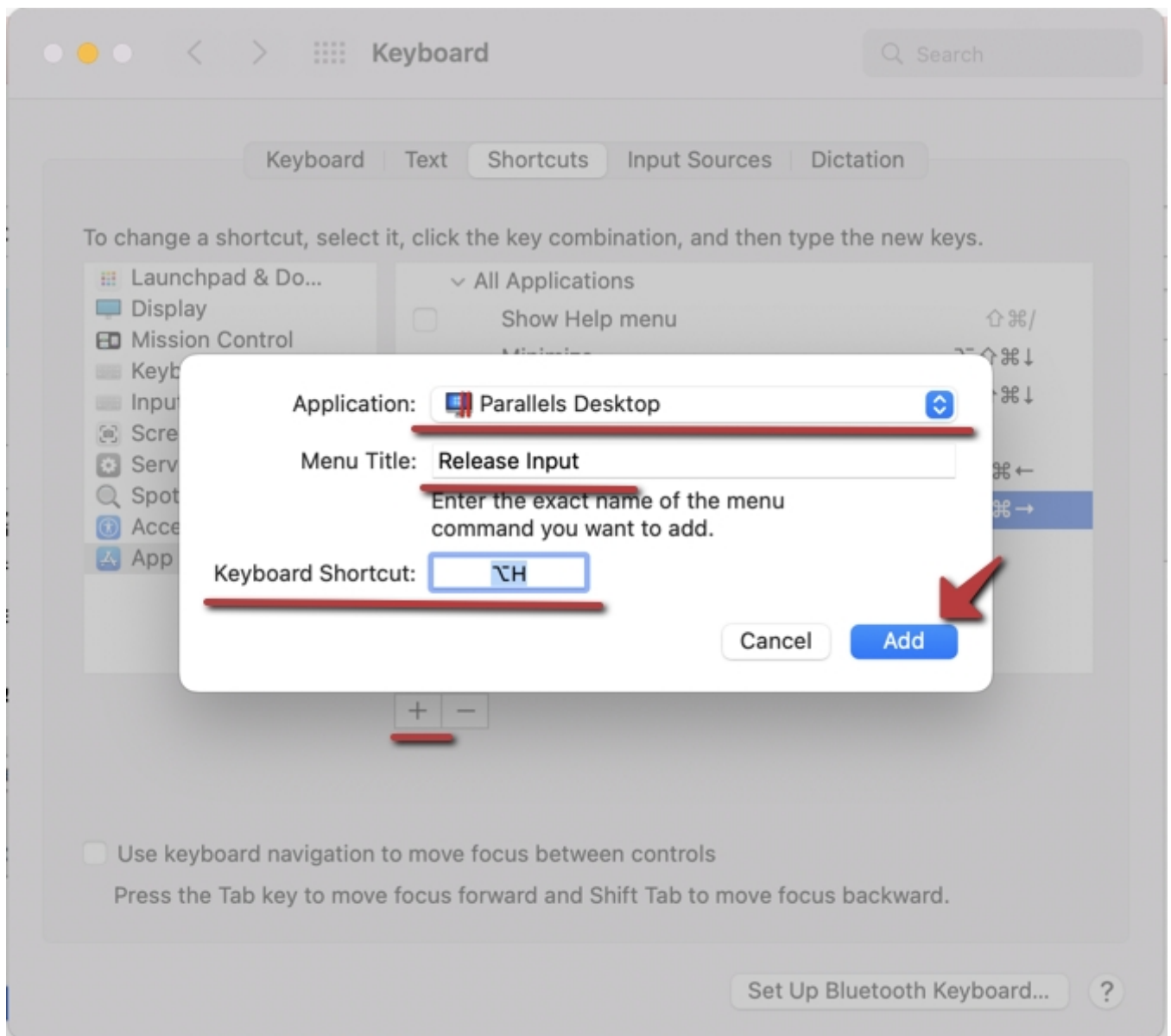
You may have noticed that when going to **Parallels Desktop Preferences > Application Shortcuts**, the **Release Input** function is set to Ctrl+Option and is grayed out, so it cannot be changed or disabled.



This is done by design so that, unless manually set by the user to some other combination, **Release Input** is always set, and cannot be disabled.

If you need to remap this function to some other key combination, please perform the following steps:

1. Click Apple logo > **System Preferences > Keyboard > Shortcuts > App Shortcuts.**
2. Click + and add a shortcut for **Release Input** menu item for **Parallels Desktop** application:



Once set, the new shortcut will be reflected in both macOS and Parallels Desktop shortcut preferences.

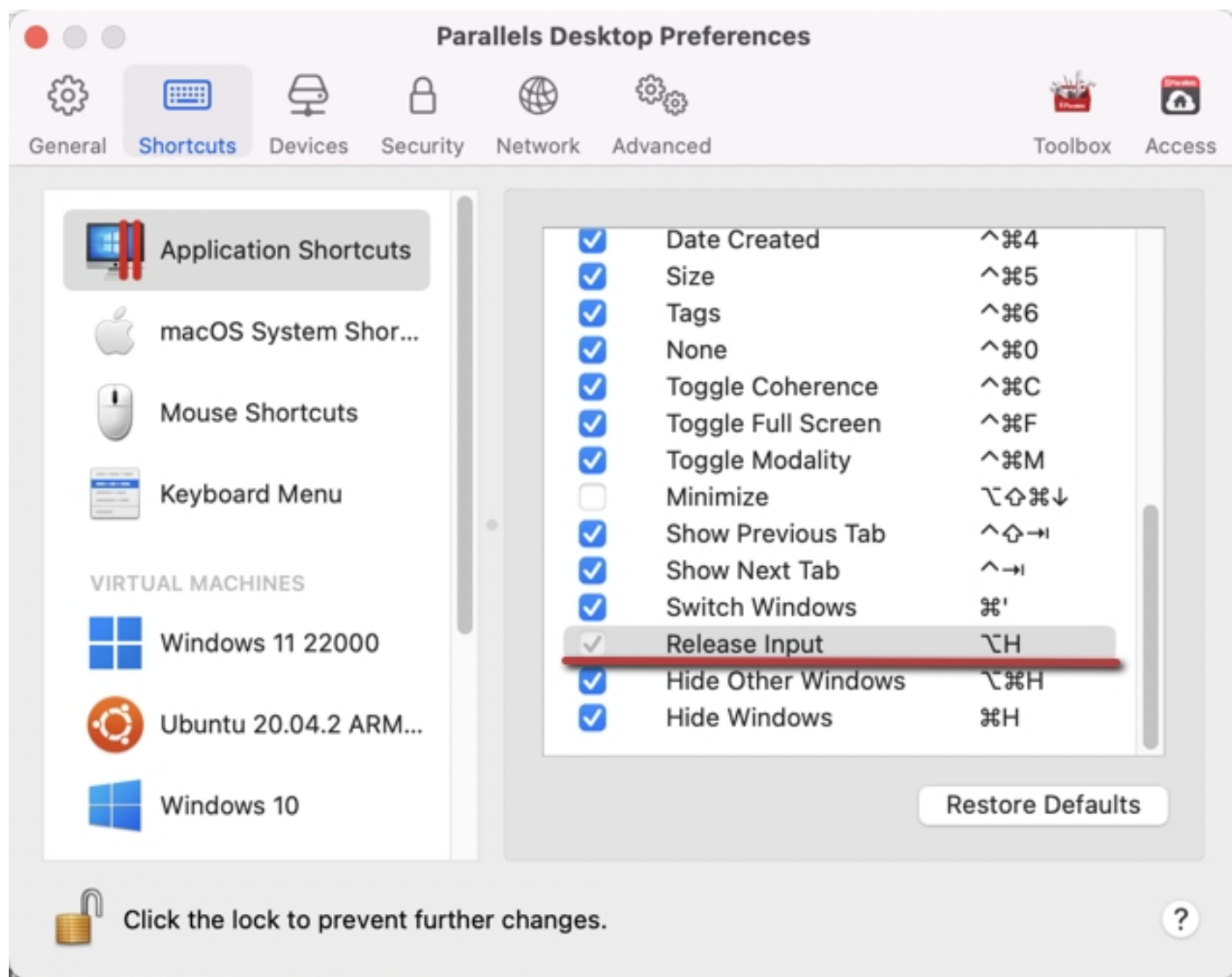


☐ Use keyboard navigation to move focus between controls
