To check Windows hard disk for errors please follow the steps below:

- 2. Click on Windows Start menu button.
- 3. In Windows Search bar type the following command:

```
cmd
```

- 4. Right click on the appeared **Command Prompt** and choose **Run as administrator**.
- 5. In Command Prompt execute the following command:
 - chkdsk C: /f /r
- 6. The system may ask you to schedule disk check for the next Windows restart. Type Y and press Enter.
- 7. Next time you restart Windows, disk check procedure will begin immediately.

At the end of the disk check process you will see the conclusion whether there were hard disk corrupted sectrors which were successfully repaired or no errors were found.
