

## A keyboard shortcut doesn't work in virtual machine

- Parallels Desktop for Mac Standard Edition
- Parallels Desktop for Mac Pro Edition
- Parallels Desktop for Mac Business Edition
- Parallels Desktop for Mac App Store Edition

## **Symptoms**

• I cannot use one of the following key combinations in my virtual machine (VM):

```
CTRL + left/right arrow
CTRL + up/down arrow
CTRL+ SHIFT + left/right arrow
CTRL + SHIFT + arrow
```

## Cause

Parallels Desktop or macOS misconfiguration.

## Resolution

To forward all keyboard shortcuts to the virtual machine (VM):

1. Open Parallels Desktop preferences > Shortcuts > macOS System Shortcuts:

Now whenever your virtual machine is in focus (mouse/keyboard control is grabbed by the VM) all Mac system shortcuts will be passed into the virtual machine, and they will work as your virtual machine's shortcuts.
Alternative solution
Ctrl+Arrow(s) keyboard combinations are assigned to Mission Control by default in macOS. You can disable these shortcuts in <b>System Preferences &gt; Keyboard &gt; Shortcuts &gt; Mission Control</b> :
