



How to enable accessibility for a specific application in OS X 10.9 Mavericks

- Parallels Desktop for Mac Standard Edition

Symptoms

Some applications stopped working properly after upgrading to OS X 10.9 Mavericks.

Cause

You need to enable access for assistive devices for the application.

Resolution

In OS X 10.9 Mavericks the settings for enabling the access for assistive devices were moved from the **Accessibility** pane to the **Security & Privacy** pane.

To enable it for a specific application please open **System Preferences ? Security & Privacy ? Privacy ? Accessibility**

Now locate your application under "Allow the apps below to control your computer" list (the list is populated automatically by OS X) and click on the check-box next to it.

If the list does not contain Parallels Desktop, then drag and drop it manually from **/Applications/** directory.

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
