

Virtual Machine crashes with BSOD 0x10e on startup

- Parallels Desktop
- Parallels Desktop for Mac Standard Edition
- Parallels Desktop for Mac Standard Edition 9 and older

Symptoms

After installing Parallels Tools in the Virtual Machine it crashes with STOP (BSOD) code 0x0000010E

Error message:

"The video memory manager has encountered an unexpected fatal error."

Your Virtual machine was migrated from a physical computer.

Resolution

- 1. Start Windows Virtual machine in Safe Mode
 - ♦ You will get to Advanced Boot Options menu, choose "Safe Mode" and press Return
- 2. After Windows is booted up in Safe Mode go to Device manager, locate DisplayLink drivers and uninstall them:
 - Go to **Start**, in the search box type **devmgmt.msc** and hit **Enter** (return).
 - ♦ Extend Display adapters right-click Displaylink adapter > Uninstall.
- 3. Start Windows installer and remove DisplayLink software:
 - ♦ Open Command Prompt: Start -> type 'cmd', right-click it -> Run as Admisinistrator.
 - ♦ In the Command Prompt execute:

```
REG ADD "HKLM\SYSTEM\CurrentControlSet\Control\SafeBoot\Minimal\MSIServer" /VE /T REG_SZ net start msiserver
```

- 4. Start -> Control Panel -> Programs and Features, locate and remove 'DisplayLink' software and click Uninstall.
- 5. Restart your Virtual machine
- 6. Go to your Virtual Machines Configuration and uncheck "Select Boot device on startup" checkbox
- 7. If you still get blue screen starting virtual machine, in virtual Machine configuration Hardware->Hard Disk1->change location to IDE 0:0

Cause

DisplayLink drivers conflict with Parallels video driver
