To change virtual machines order settings in Parallels Desktop Control Center, perform the steps below:

- 1. Launch Parallels Desktop.
- 2. While in Parallels Desktop Control Center from the top menu bar choose View option.
- 3. Then go to **Arrange By >** and switch it to **None**.
- 4. Now virtual machines list can be re-ordered according to your personal preferences.

NOTE: Bear in mind, if another option is used virtual machines list will be arranged accordingly and manual arrangement cannot be used.
