## How to disable Quick Look in Windows virtual machine?

- Parallels Desktop for Mac Standard Edition
- Parallels Desktop for Mac Pro Edition
- Parallels Desktop for Mac Business Edition

## Symptoms

When I search for a file or a folder in Windows File Explorer which contains space in its name (like Microsoft Office), pressing spacebar brings up <u>Quick Look</u> instead of just taking me to the correct path.

## Resolution

To be able to search for items without Quick Look popping up, you can disable Quick Look in Windows.

- 1. To do this, open Windows search bar and type in regedit, then hit Enter to launch it.
- 2. In the appeared **Registry Editor** window go to the following path:

HKEY\_CURRENT\_USER\Software\Parallels\Parallels Tools\GuestUtilities

3. Right-click the empty area on right side of **GuestUtilities** folder > New > String Value.

This action will create a new empty string under **GuestUtilities** folder. 4. Name the new string as **NoQuickLook** and hit Enter to save the name.

5. Restart Windows to apply changes.
