



## **RDSH Default settings managing.**

- Parallels Remote Application Server 17.0

### **Feature Description**

In **RAS v.16.5** and below you can manage **Inherit Default Settings** for each **Site** only. But since **RAS v.17** we have added the same settings for **RDSH Group**.

If a server isn't added to **RDSH Group** it has only **Site Default** settings. As per the screenshot below.

If the server is added to a group it has intermediate settings- **RDSH Group Defaults**.

If inheritance is enabled, **Site Default** overwrites **Group Default** and **Individual** settings. If **Site Default** is disabled, **Group Default** will overwrite **Individual** settings. But in both cases **Site Default** is master.

**NOTE:** Terminal server or servers must be added in **RDSH Group** if you want to manage them with **Group Default** settings.
