Symptoms

HTML5 portal fails to detect installed Parallels Client or to launch published applications with it. There are two or more gateways behind 3-rd party load balancer.

When you enable verbose logging for gateways, C: $\ProgramData\Parallels\RASLogs\HTML5GW.log$ on the servers contain records like these:

Cause

Requests from web browser and Parallels Client are routed to different gateways by the load balancer.

Resolution

Please reconfigure the load balancer for using session affinity based on cookies. HTML5 Gateway uses a cookie with ID **ASP.NET_SessionId**
