

## <u>Unwanted tray icons are redirected from Remote Desktop</u> <u>session to user PC</u>

• Parallels Remote Application Server

## **Symptoms**

Unwanted tray icons are redirected from Remote Desktop session to user PC:

## Resolution

Here are two possible solutions:

- Enable RemoteApps option for the RDSH agent;
- Or tweak the behavior of Parallels RAS Memshell mirroring technology:
- 1. Open registry editor on the RDS host from which the application in question is published.
- 2. Navigate to the following location:

For 32-bit OS: **HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\Parallels\**For 64-bit OS: **HKEY\_LOCAL\_MACHINE\SOFTWARE\WOW6432Node\Parallels\** 

- 3. Create a new key called Memshell
- 4. Within a created Memshell key create a String named **TrayIconsNoRemote**:

<b>TrayIconsNoRemote</b> value should match the exact name of the executable file of the application in question (*.exe file). Please refer to screenshot below:
To disable sending tray icons for several applications specify all executables separated by a <b>semicolon</b> :
