High Availability for RADIUS Servers

• Parallels Remote Application Server 18.0

Since RAS v18 this is now possible to specify two RADIUS hosts to provide high availability and failover.

Configuration

1. In Parallels RAS Console go to > Connection > Multi-factor Authentication tab.

2. Choose the needful RADIUS provider (e.g. DUO), specify primary and secondary RADIUS servers and High Availability mode:

The following High Availability modes are available:

- Active-active (parallel) upon authentication attempt, the request is sent to both RADIUS servers immediately and the first server which replied back will continue the work with it.
- Active-passive (failover) upon authentication attempt, the request is sent to the primary server, in case it didn't respond within specified timeout/retries we send the request to the secondary server.
