Symptoms

Cause

The RDSH where the item is published from cannot contact Domain Controllers, so NLA cannot be performed.

Resolution

Please resolve the underlying issue preventing RDSH from contacting Domain Controllers in the environment.

As a workaround, you may disable the requirement **Allow connections only from computers running Remote Desktop with NLA** in Remote Desktop properties of the RDSH:
