



Fix network not being accessible on the Mac when running Parallels Desktop

- Parallels Desktop for Mac Business Edition
- Parallels Desktop for Mac App Store Edition
- Parallels Desktop for Mac Pro Edition

You may encounter a situation when running Parallels Desktop makes network disappear on the Mac side.

Usually this behavior is caused by conflicts with 3rd party software. Parallels Development Team is investigating such cases and is working to resolve them.

Such behavior is known to occur with the following software being installed on your Mac:

- Avast Anti-Track;
- Kaspersky Internet Security;
- Endpoint Security VPN;
- Panda Security software.

Either white-listing Parallels Desktop in a given security application or sometimes completely uninstalling the application fixes the issue.

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
