

Publishing a .JAR file as a RemoteApp in Parallels Secure Workspace

• Parallels Secure Workspace

Resolution

- 1. On the RDS host, publish PowerShell as a Remote Application in the Windows Server Manager.
- 2. In the properties of the RemoteApp: navigate to the **Parameters** tab.
- 3. Select Always use the following command-line parameters and enter the following parameter: Invoke-Item "\\path\to\your\file.jar"
- 4. Test the instruction in PowerShell on the RDS host to see if the default application on the server for opening .JAR files is already Java.
- 5. **Publish** this as a **Remote Application** in Parallels Secure Workspace.
