

## **Publishing a .JAR file as a RemoteApp in Parallels Secure Workspace**

- Parallels Secure Workspace

### **Resolution**

1. On the RDS host, publish **PowerShell** as a **Remote Application** in the **Windows Server Manager**.
2. In the properties of the RemoteApp: navigate to the **Parameters** tab.
3. Select **Always use the following command-line parameters** and enter the following parameter:  
`Invoke-Item "\\path\to\your\file.jar"`
4. Test the instruction in PowerShell on the RDS host to see if the default application on the server for opening .JAR files is already Java.
5. **Publish** this as a **Remote Application** in Parallels Secure Workspace.
