

Change scaling in Red Hat Linux Enterprise (RHEL) virtual machine in Parallels Desktop on M Series Mac computers

This article will help you to solve the issue when changing scaling in Red Hat Enterprise Linux (RHEL) Arm virtual machine (VM) to 200% doesn't have any effect.

Resolution

To make 200% scaling persistent across VM window size, perform the steps below:

- 1. Start your RHEL virtual machine.
- 2. Open the Terminal within the virtual machine.
- 3. Execute the following command:

gsettings set org.gnome.desktop.interface scaling-factor 2
