Feature description

Parallels Client for Windows is able to redirect local display setup to the published desktop with the following options:

- All: All displays.
- Primary: Your primary display. You can change the primary display as described below.
- Selected: Choose one or several displays manually.

For **Selected** option, click **Configure**. To see what number corresponds to a display, click **Identify**. Newly connected displays are detected automatically. To force Client to detect new displays, click **Identify**. To change the primary display, select the display you want to be primary and click **Set primary**.

Note: this feature is designed only for the **published desktop**. Published applications will either use all the displays, or primary according to it's settings.

Use case

Local machine has 3 displays, but end user wanted to have only 2 selected in the published desktop:

• Open Connection properties > Display > Selected > Configure
