## Resolution

If you selected the **Show Windows Applications folder in Dock** option in the **Applications** pane of Virtual Machine <u>Configuration</u>, the folder with all applications installed in your Windows virtual machine will be displayed in the Dock.

You can use this folder to quickly access your Windows applications by clicking folder with Windows logo in *Dock*.

**Note:** For each virtual machine a separate folder with Windows applications is created corresponding with the name of virtual machine.

This feature will ease and speed up your access to Windows applications, especially if you are running in <b>Coherence</b> view mode. The popup menu is completely synchronized with <i>Start Menu</i> in Windows and all application you have in Windows will be accessible from <b>Windows Applications folder</b> in your Dock.
