

How to make right-click on Mac and in Parallels Desktop virtual machine

• Parallels Desktop for Mac Standard Edition

By default, Parallels Desktop is set to mimic a right-click when you press **Shift+Control** (see below) and click the mouse.

There are alternative ways to do that:

- 1. Using Apple mighty/magic mouse:
 - ♦ Click on the **Apple sign** in top left corner of your screen and choose **System Preferences**.
 - ♦ Click on Mouse and choose Click on right side in Secondary Click.
 - ♦ Now you will easily use right-click by clicking on the right side of your mouse.
- 2. If you prefer using **TrackPad** for right-click, you can follow the steps from below:
 - ♦ Click on the **Apple sign** in top left corner of your screen and choose **System Preferences**.
 - ♦ Click on TrackPad and put a checkmark on Click or tap with two fingers for Secondary click.
 - ♦ Now you can use two fingers touch for right-click.
